Damage abroad - Procedure & settlement

Step 1: Get in touch with the service hotline

1. Workshop repair abroad

- Coverage by leasing company if damage is covered (= theft/damage)
 Specialist dealer from the Lease a Bike network desirable, but not mandatory
 Invoice (= proof of damage) ideally issued to the leasing company (Digital Mobility Leasing Austria GmbH, Otto-Bauer-Gasse 6/3-5, 1060
 Vienna, ATU75746445), alternatively issued to the user
 - User pays on site → reimbursement upon presentation of invoice and proof of payment
- Repairs up to €500 → without cost estimate (but including photos and description of events)
- Repairs over €500 → only with cost estimate or quote; including photos ✓ (= proof of damage), description of the incident, and consultation
- In case of engine damage/frame damage: Return transport to Austria

 ✓ mandatory → Roland will cover the transport costs in accordance with the terms and conditions (max. €500)

2. Submission

Email with invoice/sales contract, proof of payment, details of the incident, photos to info@lease-a-bike.at (we will forward it to DML AT/Roland)

Lease a Bike will then submit the case to Roland Schutzbrief or the leasing company and provide an update.



3. 3. Rental bike / replacement mobility

3.a Acceptance in Germany and abroad in accordance with the contract or upon fulfillment of the requirements

4. Towing/transport costs

(including domestic)

4.a Up to €150 upon presentation of an invoice 4.b Flat rate of €50 without invoice (e.g., pushed by yourself, help from friends), but upon presentation of proof (e.g., photo of damaged tire/repair invoice)

5. Hotel stay

5.a Only for repairs lasting several days5.b Either hotel or return transport – not both

Prior consultation with Roland/Lease a Bike recommended – especially for damages exceeding €500.
